- What abilities you have and what you would like to get better at.



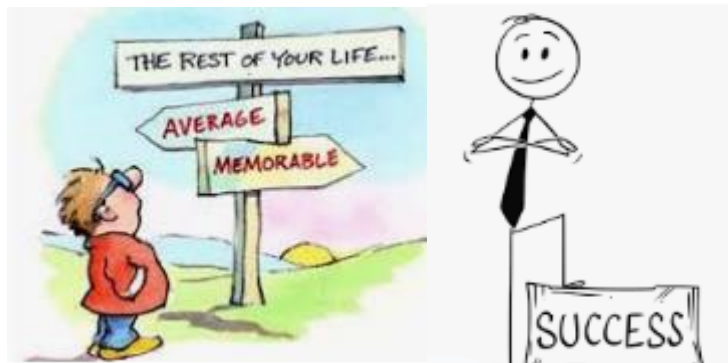
- What you would need to do to get into your chosen career.
