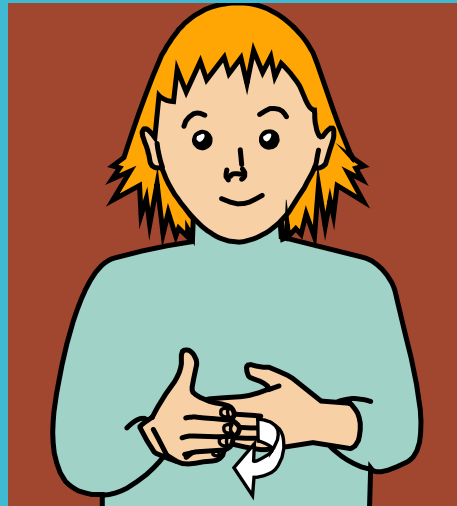

**The school entrance is at the back of the main building.**





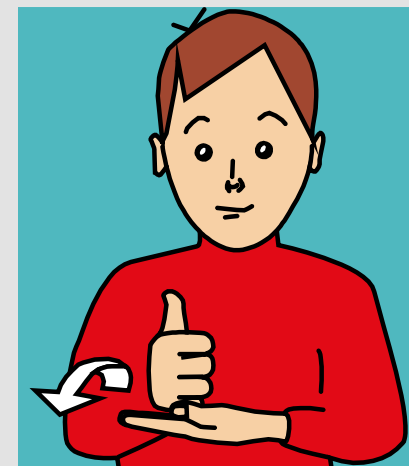


This is the School Hall.

Staff will take you to the classroom.

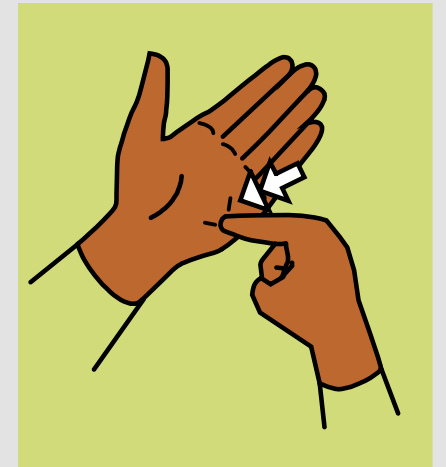
# This is the school reception.

# HERE ARE OUR TOILETS!



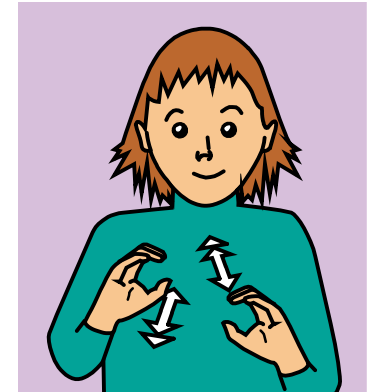
WE MUST KEEP OUR TOILETS CLEAN AND SAFE.

worries.



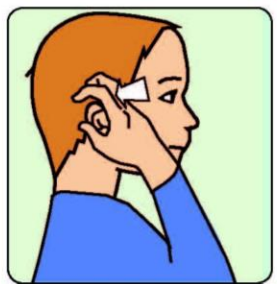




**We can see Jim, if we need a hearing test or if we have a problem with our hearing aid or Cochlear Implant. Jim is our school audiologist.**

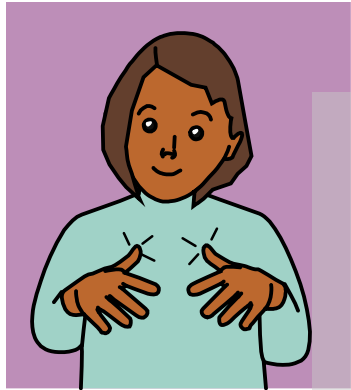

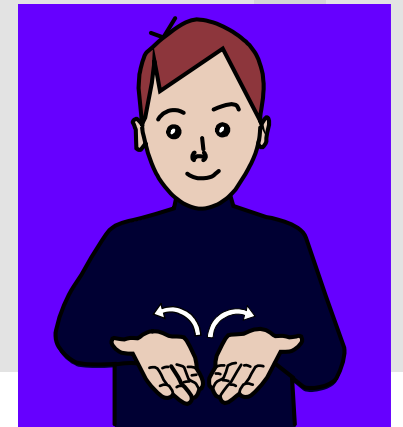
WE HAVE FUN AT PRIMARY BREAKTIME.



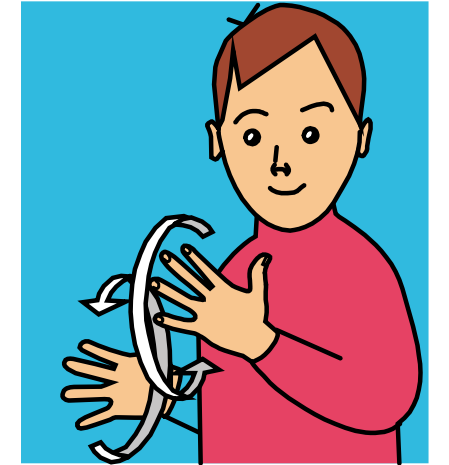




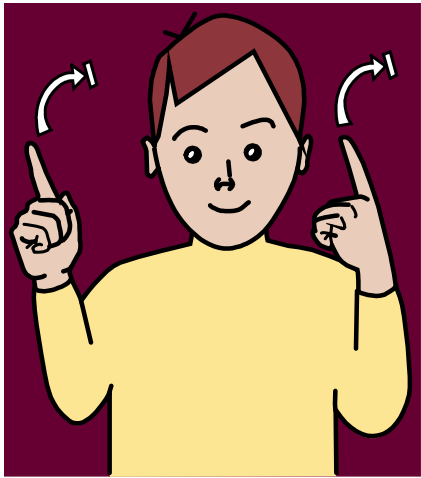
**This is our library. You can pick a book to read. You can borrow books to take home.**







**We learn BSL. Our teachers and support staff all sign. Some are Deaf and some are hearing.**

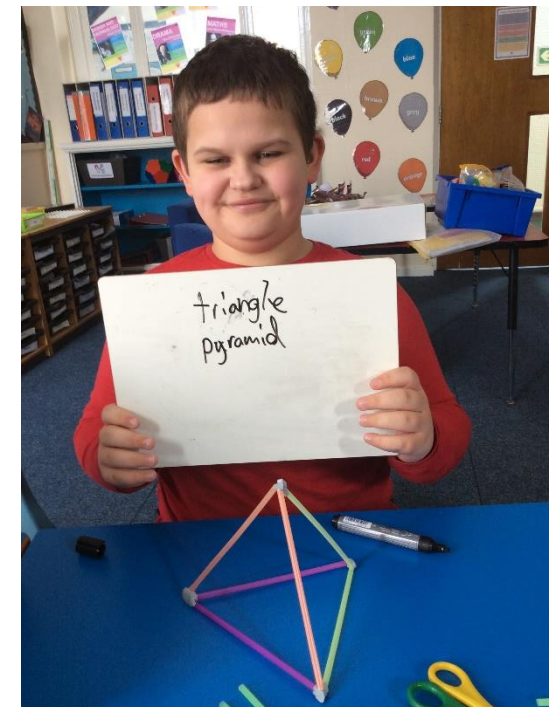
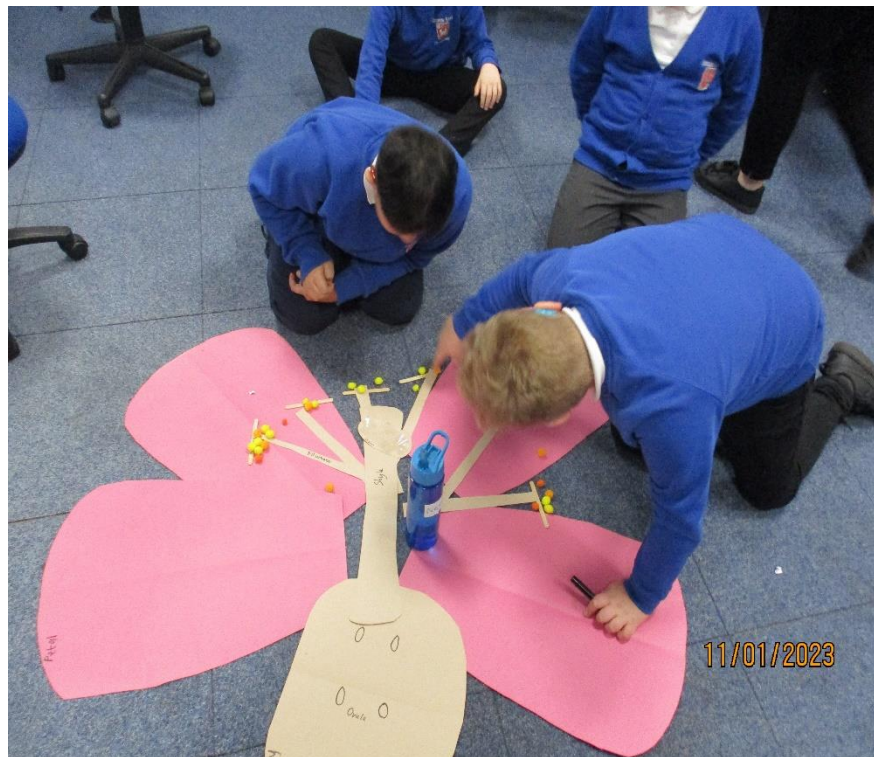
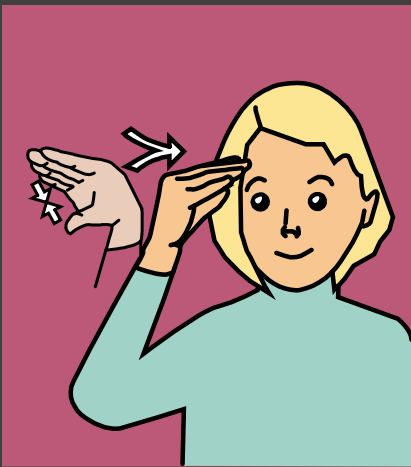


Ms Goodman is our Head Teacher and Mrs Cartlidge is our Deputy Head Teacher

If you work hard, you may be pupil of the week.

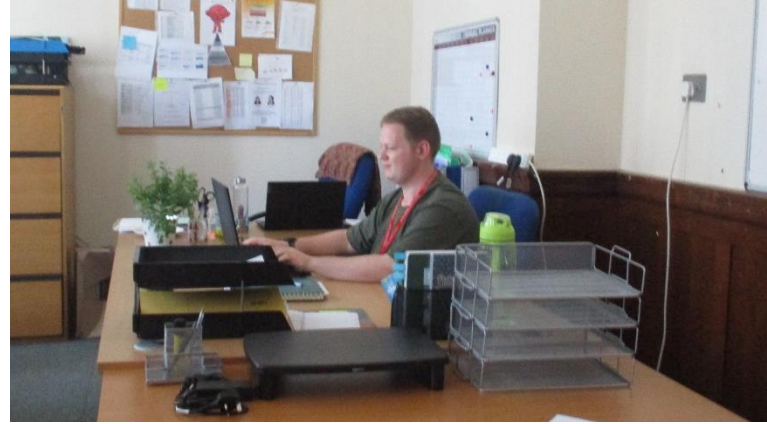


We study lots of different subjects.





# People who help us

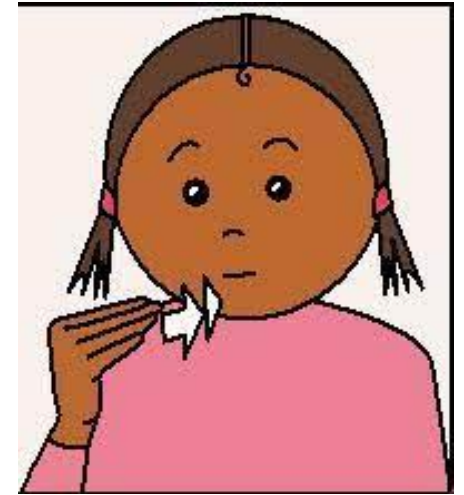


We have Speech and Language Therapists and Physical Therapists who give us extra help if we need it. There is a nurse at school too.

fruit at break time too.**

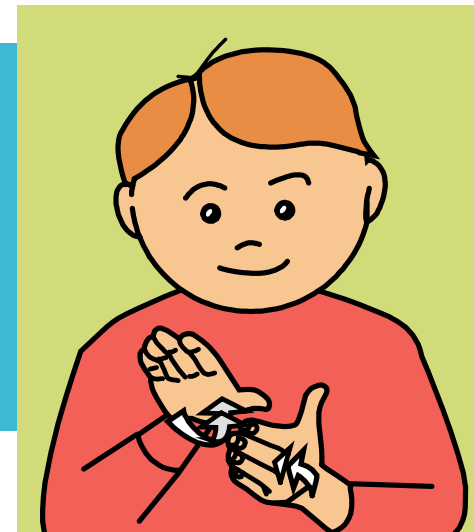
**We can choose what we

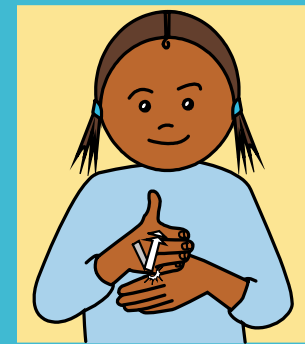
